<p><u>Literacy Activity:</u></p> <p><u>Family culture and celebrations</u></p> <p>Read this story and then talk to your child about what you may celebrate as a family, what traditions are important in your family, and how you celebrate important occasions.</p> <p>Do you make special meals?</p> <p>Do you make special events or decorations?</p> <p>What is your favorite family event?</p> <p>Activity: Family activity plan.</p> <p>Have your child create a booklet where together you can talk about things you like to do as a family.</p> <p>Your child can dictate what activities they enjoy, and then make a drawing of mentioned activities</p> <p>Song: about Family together with love</p>	<p><u>Math Activity: Setting the table (Counting activity)</u></p> <p>Talk to you child about what goes on the table when you set it up for a family meal.</p> <p>How many items do they need?</p> <p>What items do they need and why?</p> <p>Take this time to perhaps talk about the various shapes each item is and even classify by type of item.</p> <p>Example: Rectangle: Table and table mat</p> <p>Circle: Plates</p> <p>Sorting: spoons, forks, cups plates.</p>	<p><u>Science Activity: "Make Stone soup"</u></p> <p>Watch this story about a Man that was unable to get help from the village when he was hungry, but then came up with a way to trick the village into helping in creating a delicious "Stone Soup"</p> <p>This story's focus is mainly on the way people can come together and share what they have to create a big meal.</p> <p>Many families do this all the time, during any celebration you may have.</p> <p>Talk to your child about what ingredients are needed to make a good soup.</p> <p>Discuss ways in which family members can help in making a meal.</p> <p>How does it feel to come together as a family to share a meal?</p> <p>What are some favorite meals your family may have?</p> <p>Here is a fun video about making apple pie.</p>	<p><u>Art Activity: Thankful Pie</u></p> <p>NO school Today</p> <p>Thanksgiving Holiday</p> <p>Here is a song about being Thankful And here is a bilingual song as well.</p> <p>If you want to do an activity today, here is a Thankful Pumpkin Pie activity.</p>	<p><u>Social-Emotional/Movement Activity:</u></p> <p>No school Today</p> <p>Holiday weekend</p> <p>But here is a beautiful story about family and the various structures it may come in.</p> <p>If you're thankful and you know it sing this song!</p>
